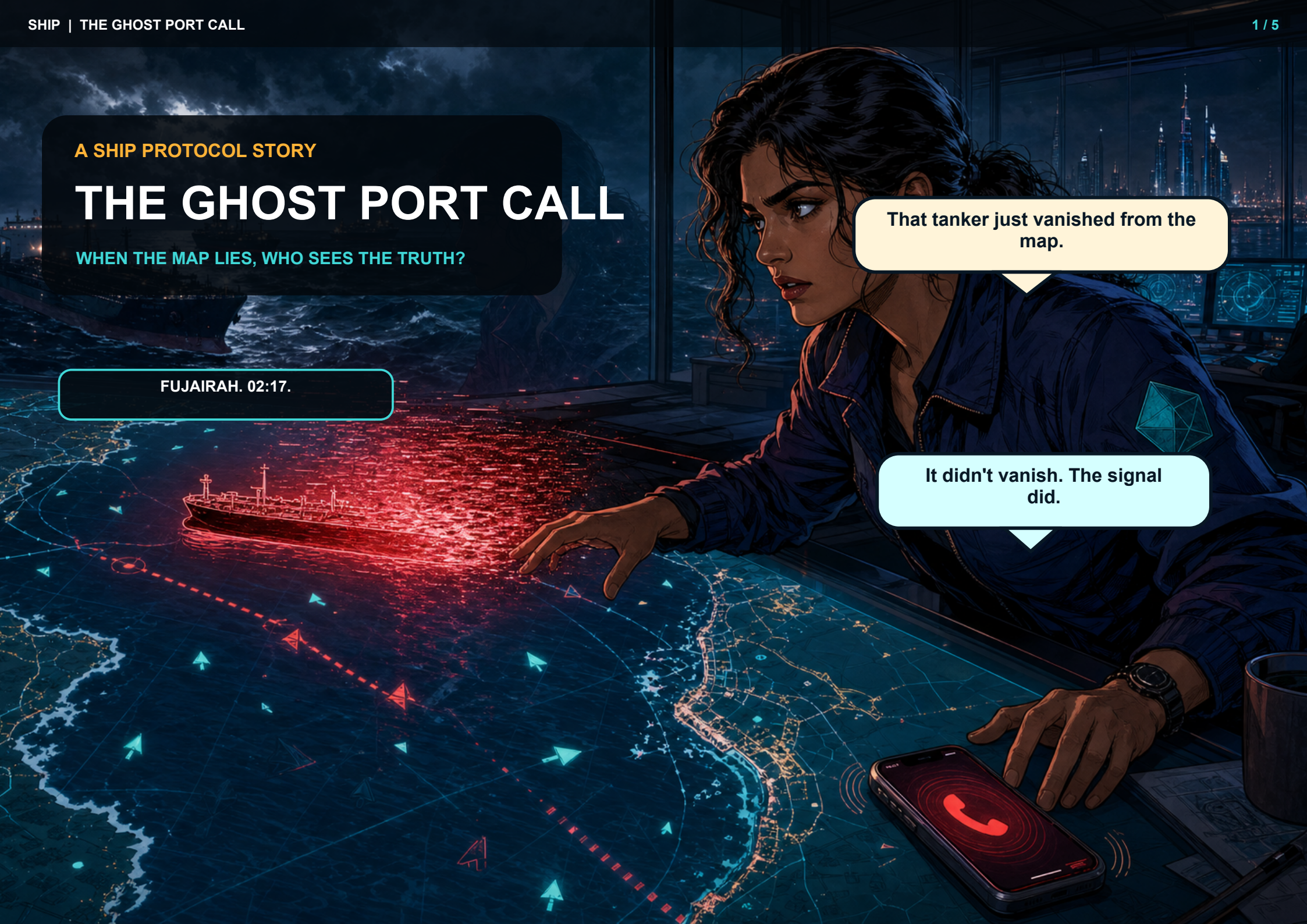
THE GHOST PORT CALL

We do not accuse. We verify.



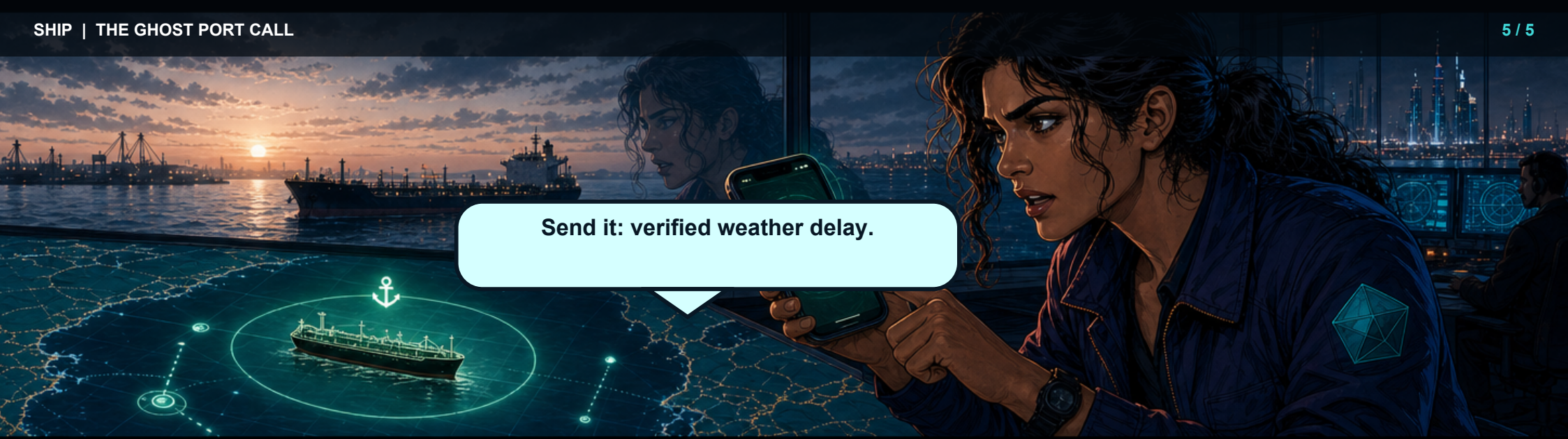
AIS says one thing. The sea says another.
